# Kumagaya Taking out the trash

Please help us in reducing waste and properly separating and disposing of it.

## Rules for putting out garbage


- **Put them out at the designated time and date**  
Please sort garbage and recyclables using the prescribed method when disposing of them.  
Put them out by 8:30 AM on the day for your area.
  - **Where to put garbage**  
Put it in the designated collection site for your area.  
Put it under the crow net or in the container.  
Garbage put out after collection cannot be picked up.
  - **Bags used for each type of garbage**
    - Burnable garbage**  
Put it in a transparent or translucent bag.
    - Non-burnable garbage**  
Put it in a transparent bag.
- Remove air from bags and close them securely.

## Treat the collection sites with respect

Collection sites are managed and maintained with the help of local residents.  
In order to keep the collection sites clean, please follow etiquette such as properly separating and disposing of garbage and do not put out garbage on non-collection days.  
Please note that garbage from businesses cannot be disposed of at collection sites.

## Notes

- Drain liquids from food waste before putting it out.
- Remove air from bags and close them securely.
- Disassemble large wooden furniture as best as you can. If you cannot carry it to the collection site, use a "Paid Collection Request".
- Fold futons and carpets and tie them with string. Remove controllers and cords from heated carpets and put them out with non-burnable garbage.
- Place waste securely beneath nets or in containers at collection sites so that crows or other animals can't reach it.

### Tree branches



Cut to less than 60 cm in length and tie in a bundle under 30 cm in diameter, and take out 2 or 3 bundles at a time.

\* Tree trunks greater than 15 cm in diameter cannot be collected or processed.


\* Please refrain from putting out large amounts of garbage at one time.

# Recyclables (paper)

Tie together with a string

## Main items

### Newspapers and flyers




Tie them in a bundle or put them in a paper bag from a newspaper stand.

### Books




Magazines, comic books, books, and paperbacks

### Cardboard (Cardboard boxes and cardboard packing)



Break down and tie together with a string.

### Paper packaging from drinks (Milk and juice cartons)




Rinse, break apart, let dry, and then tie with a string or put in a paper bag before putting them out.

Sake and soy milk packs with aluminum insides should be put out on burnable garbage days.





Tie together with a string or put them in a paper bag.



Notepads, calendars, wrapping paper, post-cards, shoe boxes, tissue paper boxes, posters, etc. are all considered miscellaneous paper.

Please remove the plastic portion of tissue boxes, envelopes, etc.

You don't need to put them in a plastic bag





## Paid Collection Requests

If you want to throw away large furniture or oversized garbage but cannot carry it to or leave it at the collection site, we accept "Paid Collection Requests" where we pick it up at your residence.

Request a pickup by calling

**Kumagaya Environment Beautification Center (TEL 048-524-7121)**

- We cannot enter residences, so please leave them outside your door.
- For apartments, we can only pickup items that can fit in stairways and elevators.
- Up to 5 items can be collected once.
- You must be present during collection.
- The cost is 520 yen per cubic meter.

## Items subject to the Home Appliance Recycling Law



We do not collect TVs (CRT / LCD / Plasma), air conditioners, refrigerators, freezers, washing machines, and dryers. They cannot be put out at collection sites.

They can be disposed of by either coordinating with the store you purchased it from or the store where you plan to purchase a replacement, or by paying the fee with a post office transfer and then bringing it directly to a pick-up location.

# Non-burnable garbage

Separate and put in a transparent bag

## Main items

Food and drink cans




Food and drink bottles



Disposable lighters \*1



Spray cans,  
Gas cartridges \*2



Plastic bottles  
(Bottles with a PET mark)



Non-burnable garbage  
(ceramics, cosmetic bottles,  
frypans, etc.)



- \*1 Remove all gas from disposable lighters, place them in a transparent bag separate from cans, and put them out on the collection day for cans.
- \*2 Empty the contents of spray cans and gas cartridges, then puncture all containers, place them in a transparent bag separate from bottles, and put them out on the collection day for bottles.

## More examples of non-burnable garbage

Glasses, cups, vases, flower pots, metal hangers, pots, kettles, scissors, cans and bottles not used for food and drink, light bulbs (other than fluorescent and mercury lamps)

## Notes

- Remove air from bags and close them securely.
- Please wash the inside of cans, glass, and plastic bottles.
- Remove the caps from glass and plastic bottles, and put plastic bottles with burnable garbage and metal bottles with non-burnable garbage.
- Never dispose of disposable lighters, spray cans, or gas cartridges with other garbage.
- Wrap the blade of sharp items like kitchen knives, knives, box knives, razors, etc., with tape or newspaper and place them in a transparent bag.
- Wrap broken glasses or cups in multiple layers to prevent tearing the plastic bag.


## Do not put in bags

### Batteries



Put them in collection containers inside city hall, administrative centers, community centers, etc., or collection containers located inside appliance stores.

### Thermometers and blood-pressure monitors that use fluorescent tubes, mirrors, or mercury




Put them in collection containers located inside city hall, administrative centers, community centers, etc.

Incandescent bulbs, LED bulbs, and electronic thermometers are non-burnable garbage.

## Put in a bag

### Heat-not-burn tobacco and electronic cigarettes with built-in lithium-ion batteries



Put them in collection containers located inside city hall, administrative centers, community centers, etc.







The first box containing a computer is free when collected from your residence.

Cables, monitors, mice, keyboards, computer parts, boards, and other components can also be collected if they are placed inside the same box as the computer.

- \* Remove batteries, fluorescent tubes, mirrors, and thermometers from bags before placing them in collection containers.
- \* Put heat-not-burn tobacco and electronic cigarettes in a clear plastic bag without disassembling them, tie the bag shut, write "heat-not-burn tobacco" or "electronic cigarette" on the bag, and then place the bag in the battery collection container.




